Course Description: Effective Treatment of Back Pain with Manual Physical Therapy

Back pain is one of the most common ailments in the human population. Many therapists are frustrated by patients that complain of back pain and do not have stellar success rates when treating the back. This course will provide a review of anatomy specifically related to the vertebral facets and their role in dysfunction and pain. Concepts of muscle energy and myofascial release will be described, demonstrated and practiced. This course will present gentle positional techniques that use the patient's active muscle contraction force to release restrictions and promote enhanced normal joint motion. This course is for physical therapists and physical therapist assistants.

This course involves laboratory practice and therefor is limited to a maximum of 25 participates. The first 25 participant registration received will be accepted into the course.

- 4. Treat myofascial structures in the back using myofascial release techniques.
