



## Occupational Therapy Assistant Program Application Orientation

Welcome to the Application Process for the MSC Occupational Therapy Assistant (OTA) programs. This application orientation class will provide you with all the information you need to complete the OTA application process. To be eligible to apply to the OTA Program you must attend an application orientation class. If you have questions, **after** you have attended an application orientation class and have reviewed all available materials, you are encouraged to email the program office, we are glad to help you.

The OTA application process is occurring in the spring of each year. If you are accepted into the program, then you will begin the second year of the OTA program in fall intersession 2016. This will be explained more at the orientation meeting.

Follow these directions to access the application links:

1. Go to the Murray State College Allied Health Programs home page – [www.mscah.org](http://www.mscah.org)
2. From there go to the Application Information page.
3. At the bottom of that page, find the link to OTA Program Application Links.
4. Complete all required forms located on the OTA Application Links page and submit your application as instructed.

You should read all instructions and complete the application as instructed. You may fill in the application on-line but you will need to print off the application and related documents. Once you have completed the application you will need to submit the signed application and all related documents in the large **GREEN** envelope provided you at your application orientation class. You will need to mail or bring your signed application and attached documentation to the OTA Program office.
