Outcomes Information for the most recent three class years (2020, 2021, 2022) the following information is provided:

- Graduation rates for these three years are: 2020 – 83.3%, 2021 – 88%, and 2022 – 72%. This data reflects that reported to CAPTE and is based on the completion of students offered a position in the class.
- Over ninety percent (> 90%) of students who begin the Fall Semester of the technical year of the PTA program during these three years successfully completed the PTA program. Over 85% of students who were offered an initial position in a class ultimately completed the program successfully.
- Graduates during this period have over a 85% ultimate pass rate on the NPTE licensure examination.
- Graduates who sought employment report finding jobs within 3 months of graduation. The employment rate is calculated based on those graduates who were seeking employment and found employment (FT, PT, or contract) within 12 months of graduation. Graduates from these classes report high job satisfaction (> 90%) on graduate surveys.
- Supervising PTs and employers report graduates performing at appropriate entry-level and that they would hire a graduate from the MSC PTA program again. (>95%)

* Class of 2021 – 15 students graduated of those 8 passed on their initial attempt and 3 passed on their 2nd attempt. This will be updated as the remaining 4 students pass on future attempts in 2022 & 2023.

** Class of 2022 – Graduated in August, as of the date of this update, 6 of 11 students have taken the NPTE Licensure Exam and all have passed. The remaining 5 students plan to take in 2023. Ultimate Pass Rate will be updated after all students have taken the exam.

[^] Employment rate includes those licensed graduates who sought employment and who found employment (FT, PT, Contract) as identified by the graduate survey and state licensure identification of workplace. The employment rate for one-year post-graduation will be posted once graduate survey data is received.
