



## Physical Therapist Assistant Program Application Orientation

2018/2019 Technical Year Class

Welcome to the Application Process for the MSC Physical Therapist Assistant (PTA) programs.

This letter provides a summary of the application process that you will need to complete in order to apply to the technical portion of the PTA program for the Class of 2019. To be eligible to apply to the PTA Program you must view the on-line application orientation video. If you have questions, **after** you have viewed the entire video and reviewed all application materials, you are encouraged to email the program office, we are glad to help you.

The PTA application process begins in September during the Fall Semester. Application Information is linked to the program web site. The due date for the submission of the application packet to the program office is the third Thursday in November which is November 16, 2017 for this application period. If you are accepted you will notified in mid-December and will begin two PTA courses in the spring (PTA 2112 & PTA 2103). These courses include both on-line and in-class components and will require you to be on campus one day per week. You will need to complete these two PTA courses along with any remaining program prerequisite courses you may lack prior to the beginning of the Fall 2018 semester. This will be explained more in the orientation video.

Follow these directions to access the application links:

1. Go to the Murray State College Allied Health Programs home page – [www.mscah.org](http://www.mscah.org)
2. From there go to the Application Information page.
3. Find the link to the PTA Program Application Orientation Video and view this video in its entirety. You will be required to demonstrate that you have viewed the video by including the answers to three questions from the video.
4. Locate the link to PTA Program Application materials.
5. Complete all required forms located on the PTA Application Links page and submit your application as instructed.

You should read all instructions and complete the application as instructed. You may fill in the application on-line but you will need to print off the application and related documents. Once you have completed and signed the application you will need to submit the signed application and all related documents in the large **GREEN** envelope that you will pick up in the program office when you pick up your "Ticket to Test" for the program admission test. You will need to mail or bring your signed application packet that includes the application and required documentation to the PTA Program office.
